**SOME THINGS CONSIDERED**

Today is the Feast of the Epiphany. The word is from the Greek 'Epiphania', which means 'to show forth'. On this Feast the Church celebrates the showing forth or revealing of Jesus to the world.

The world is represented by the Three Kings who this day arrive at the Manger in Bethlehem. They are seeking one whom they have only heard whispers of, whispers in the heavens and in the Holy Books. Based on little more than that they set out seeking and longing.

The journey of these Kings might be a good time for you to get in touch with your own longing for Jesus, your seeking Him out. These Kings of old risked a great deal in looking for him. The path was not clear, no smooth roads or 'map quest' searches to define the way. So how tough a journey am I ready to make in seeking Him in my life?

Taken seriously, faith will push us to the limit. Or like these Kings of old will set us onto paths unknown.

Throughout the Advent/Christmas Season we have been responding to the Intercessions: "Be Born in us; Be born in our world." The Christmas Season concludes today, but His birthing does not. We do well to think on how He has been born in us the more in these days. We do well to think on how deeply is our longing that He be born in us the more in the days and year to come. We do well in these days to think on how He is born in our world specifically through each of us. We are His flesh on blood from Sunday to Sunday in our homes and places of work, in the line at stores and stop lights, all the parts of our lives. He is born in us. Epiphany is just the time to think on just how that has happened, like the Kings to recognize Him and like these Kings to long for Him even more. Have a wonderful week. Love, Fr. Peter

### FAITH FORMATION/YOUTH MINISTRY

Dear Church Family,

Here is a little catechism lesson on the Feast of the Epiphany. The word "Epiphany" means, "manifestation" or "revelation," as God is "manifested" into human form. *"And the Word was made flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we saw his glory, the glory of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth."* (John 1:14) This is a feast that is steeped in tradition, and is also known as "Little Christmas" by the Irish, and "Three Kings Day" by the Hispanic community. Epiphany is also known as the feast of light, as the light of Christ has entered our world! In the United States this feast occurs on the first Sunday after the first Saturday of the new year. Tomorrow (Monday) is the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, and that will officially close out the Christmas Season. On Tuesday of this week we will again enter into Ordinary Time. I hope this information was helpful to you. Our Catholic faith is overflowing with ritual and custom, and it's always good to learn as much about it as we can!

Today's gospel reading comes from St. Mark and describes the visit by the Magi to the Christ child. Our music director, Barbara, will probably grace us with the song "We Three Kings" today, however, nowhere in the reading does it actually say there were **3** kings. Interestingly, the line that stood out to me in this reading came from King Herod (who tried to trick the Magi into revealing where the Savior was so he could be killed). **"Go and search diligently for the child."** That's what we should all be doing, or what we should be continuing to do. Once the Christmas Season has past, and the tree is out to the curb, and the festive decorations returned to storage, we ourselves often revert back to our "ordinary" selves. I think it's important to remember what it was that we were (and hopefully still are) celebrating...the birth of the Christ (*and he was made flesh and made his dwelling among us*). We must continue to diligently search for Jesus in all that we do and wherever we go. He is there, we just sometimes forget that.
