FAITH FORMATION ...

Dear Church Family,

Today's readings focus on **call**. What does it mean to be called? Yes, that is the question. We had a lengthy discussion in our staff meeting this week regarding what call really means to us today. Although our interpretations varied, we all agreed that God does call us, but to what? Well, here's my take on this.

In the first reading, God repeatedly called Samuel, however it took Samuel awhile to recognize God was truly calling him. Samuel's reply (at Eli's suggestion) was astonishing – "Speak, Lord, your servant is *listening*." Likewise, in the Gospel reading, John, identifying Jesus as "the Lamb of God," (I love that title, and it's only found in John's Gospel) answered his own call by following Jesus (along with Simon Peter and Andrew). They, like Samuel, *listened* and then *answered*. I think that's what we today find difficult, the *listening* part. As a society, we don't listen well to each other, so actually listening to – and then carrying out what God wants for us (and from us) can be tricky. Why? Probably because we're scared. We don't like change, and following a call requires that. As our faith life grows and alters, so too does our call. Being open to what God is asking of us, is part of our Christian heritage – we are *called* by our Baptism in Christ. So, here is some practical advice on how we can answer that call.

- Pray – it sounds simplistic, but it's not. Ask God to help you *listen*, not just to him, but to those around you as well.
- Spend some time with Scripture. Randomly open your Bible, and see where God leads you. Then reflect on what you've read, and *listen* to what it says about your life.
- Talk to those close to you, and ask them to share the gifts they see in you. *It's often hard to see in ourselves what others may see in us.*
- If there is something you feel God is calling you to do, then *just do it!* I know, I stole this from the Nike commercials, but even if you're anxious to start something new...at least try. And ask for God's help and guidance on your journey.

Finally, please remember that in all that we do, God walks beside us. It's only appropriate that we should do the same...walk with God in all that we do. Have a wonderful week. Love, Jeanette
