## Other Things Considered...

Only Father Peter and I have access to and decide on the use of those monies you so generously donate. We are very careful with it. We don't help the same people regularly. I am very clear with them that what we have is limited and needs to be used in emergency situations. Social Services and other social service agencies need to be their first call.*

*Generally speaking we fill out a form for each person that indicates what their need is and what help they already receive. We decide from that how and if we can help. We also share with them what other help is available elsewhere. So in a nutshell, that's how our poor fund is used. If you have any questions, please e-mail, call me or just ask me some weekend.*

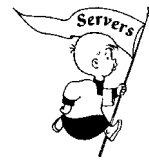

Dear Church Family,

This week's readings (like many other weeks as well) instruct us how to follow God. Unlike last week, in which the reading focused on God's call, today they pointedly refer to a specific way of life.

The prophet Jeremiah poetically speaks to us of the dangers we may encounter if we put our trust in humans rather than God. *"Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings."* BUT... *"Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord."*

In the second reading St. Paul warns the Corinthians (and us as well) that if we don't believe in the risen Christ, our faith is worthless.

And finally in the gospel reading from St. Luke we experience the "Sermon on the Plain," in which Jesus (in my opinion) lovingly explains the rewards we are given by living with faith in God. Unlike St. Matthew's "Sermon on the Mount," St. Luke depicts the poor as hungry, where as St. Matthew describes us as spiritually poor. St. Luke seems to be more interested in those who are physically needy, rather than those who are spiritually so. Regardless of how we see this, the fact is that our faith, and God's presence in our lives, provides us with the graces we need to survive. And to not only survive, but to thrive!

This gospel reading is one of my favorites. I've told you all previously how I sometimes get goose bumps when I read these passages because they can seem so real to me. I consider that to be a grace as well. Whenever any of us feel badly, for whatever reason, we have these wonderful graces to fall back on. And remember...**"Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord,"** and **"Blessed are they who hope in the Lord,"** because without that hope and trust in our risen Lord, our faith is worthless.
