## FAITH FORMATION ...

Dear Church Family,

Try as I might, I could not come up with much of a reflection on today's Gospel from St. Mark. I don't know, something about wineskins just didn't sit right with me, so I thought, "Hey, this coming week we'll be celebrating Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent" so here is a bit of information that you may find useful regarding the special season.

Please take note of the bulletin insert on the Season of Lent. This information was garnered from the Sadlier web page, and I found it very informative, so I decided to share it with you.

Also, directly below you will find a list of **Lenten Penitential Regulations** we received from the Diocesan office.

- **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fasting and abstinence.**
- **All other Fridays during the season of Lent are days of abstinence.**
- **Abstinence refers to not eating meat. All persons fourteen years of age and up are obliged to abstain.**
- **Fasting refers to eating only one full meal a day with smaller portions that do not constitute a full meal at the other two meal times. Adults eighteen years of age up to the age of sixty are obliged to fast.**

The Ashes we receive on Ash Wednesday are an early symbol of repentance. They also remind us of our humanity ("remember that you are dust, an unto dust you shall return"). Receiving ashes at the beginning of Lent shows our need for a deeper conversion in our lives during this season of Lent, which is a season of renewal.

I will endeavor to share some Lenten facts with you all over the next several weeks. There is a lot of information to be found in a variety of sources regarding this Season, and I encourage you all to do a bit of research on the subject. However, let's remember that with every season we celebrate, and in our everyday life as well, prayer should be in the forefront.

***God, giver of every moment, help me to celebrate joyful moments and to hold firm in moments of challenge. When I am in trouble, Lord, help me turn to you. Help me to trust you and to follow the example of your son, Jesus. This Lent, help me reach out to those who feel alone and isolated. Let me be a visible sign of your love and the love of your son, Jesus Christ.***

***Amen.***
