FAITH FORMATION ...

Dear Church Family,

This week's Gospel reading starts out so beautifully... "Lifting his eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed." What an incredible image, and one that causes us to put into perspective the inner suffering that Jesus endured. All of us can relate to that, and in our suffering (whether it be a bad day at work, or something much more substantial) we too should seek out the help of God in prayer. Jesus' example is one we would do well to follow. Prayer in itself allows us a deeper and more intimate relationship with God. The beauty of this Gospel passage is the prayer itself, also known as the "High Priestly Prayer," in which Jesus asks for God's protection for his disciples, and goes on to further ask for them to be "consecrated in truth." This prayer is for all of us, so that in this consecration we may be faithful to our mission. And what is the mission? We are called to pass on and spread our faith in Jesus. We too are disciples, and we should take this role seriously.

I meet weekly with the 5th graders of SMS, to go over the Sunday readings with them. This week I discussed how we should show (and spread) the love of God and our faith with others. They came up with some great (and elaborate) ways to do this, but it's really not that hard. We must simply strive to live our life in Jesus. Our goal is for others to see the way we live, and want to emulate that. If we live in faith, which is the love of God, we live a good life. Isn't that what we all hope for? As St. John says in today's second reading, "God is love, and whoever remains in love remains in God and God in him." That pretty much hits the nail of the head!

This past Monday we celebrated the life of John Cass in a memorial service that was filled the church! What a testament to the Cass family, and to John himself. We are so blessed to live and worship in a community that cares so deeply for others. That is what the love of God is all about, and it is through this love, and the faith in our risen Lord that we are carried through both good and bad times. So, like Jesus—lift your eyes to heaven, and pray. Pray through your struggles, and pray through your joys. And remember that through it all, God walks beside you. Have a wonderful week.
