FAITH FORMATION ...

Dear Church Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Last week I wrote about the Holy Spirit, and how I see it at work in so many of us! The Holy Trinity is another one of those "mysteries" of our faith. Something we believe, but may not completely understand. *Three persons, one God.* How many of us pray the Sign of the Cross daily, and don't think twice about the significance of it? This symbol of our faith is a very old and important one. As in today's Gospel reading from St. Matthew, we too, like the disciples before us, are baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Jesus instructs us all to "make disciples of all nations." (*Matthew 28:12*) This symbol of the cross is used not only in baptism, but also in the sacraments of confirmation, anointing of the sick, and ordination. On Ash Wednesday a cross of ashes is placed on our forehead. When we enter and leave the church, most of us bless ourselves with the holy water by making the Sign of the Cross. We (along with the priest) use our thumb to trace a cross on our forehead, lips and heart before the Gospel reading. This is to ask for God's blessing to open our minds to hear God's word, to share God's word with others, and to let the word of God renew our hearts. These are all traditional and vital aspects of Catholic worship. Our belief in the Holy Trinity, along with our belief of the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, sets us apart from other Christians. *This is our faith, the faith of the Church.* So, the next time you pray the Sign of the Cross, try to place some importance in the prayer. Mystery or not, it's what we believe.

And, speaking of "Mysteries..." Last Saturday was the Jr. High Youth group "Mystery Trip." We had a fun (but chilly and wet) day at Seabreeze Park! The 16 kids really enjoyed themselves, despite the rain, and the chaperones endeavored to stay as warm and dry as possible. My thanks goes out to Elaine Housecamp and Jim Coleman, who helped me keep track of the kids at the park. Jim also did the roller coaster run with the kids, while Elaine and I stuck to Skee ball. The consensus among the kids is no more end of the year "Mystery Trip," just an end of the year Seabreeze trip!
