So, I thank you in advance for your prayers and support. That is one thing that I've always been able to count on here at St. Michael's. I truly am grateful, and I'm blessed.

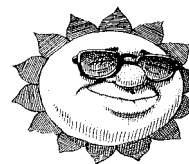
Have a wonderful week...oh and don't forget about Vacation Bible School (Aug. 14-18)! I'm still looking for help in several areas. Call or email me if you're available!
