*SOME THINGS CONSIDERED*

**NEW ORGAN FOR ST. MICHAEL'S**

I arrived at St. Michael's eleven years ago this month and one of the first issues brought to my attention was the deteriorating condition of the church organ. The instrument that currently serves our church was purchased used around 1918. It was assembled from several other organs and came to us as new to you. It has served us well. The notice I received eleven years ago was ominous. In the intervening time we have accumulated the funds needed to replace the organ. I have told you several times over recent years about the steps being taken in this regard. At the end of June, I signed a contract with the Parson's Organ Builders of Bristol, NY to construct a new instrument for us. It will utilize the best parts of our instrument as well as pipes from another organ. Everything that you will see and much of the sound created by our new organ will be brand new. Our contract with Parsons stipulates that the current organ is removed from the church in October 2007. We will be without an organ through June of 2008. In June of 2008 the new organ will be installed. I have arranged for Bishop Clark to join the parish community on Sunday Sept. 28, 2008 (the day before the Feast of St. Michael) in order to dedicate the new organ for our church.

This fall we will have drawings available of how the new instrument will appear. There will be times during construction when it will be demonstrated in the shop in Bristol which people will be welcome to participate in. Our current instrument is 12 ranks of pipes the new organ will be 20. Our current instrument weighs about 5000 pounds the new organ will weigh over 11,000 pounds. It will fill the church with a glorious sound and serve the people of our parish for generations. Have a good week.

## FIESTA

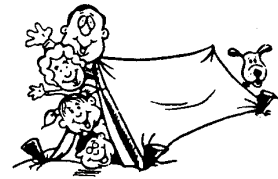
