You know by now that our dear Charlotte went home to God in the early evening of Monday last. I barely know how to begin to reflect on Char. To the best of my knowledge Char's only teaching position was in our school spanning eighteen years. She became Principal in 1980, the first lay person in that position at St. Michael's and retired from that role in 1993. Shortly thereafter Fr. Ed prevailed upon her to become the Coordinator of Liturgy for the parish a position she held until the end of June this year. It is no understatement to say that Charlotte has given her life to the children and people of St. Michael's.

I arrived in June of 1995 and Char promptly took me under her wing guiding me through the thicket of our liturgical life and giving sage advice in a wide range of parish issues. I never failed to be amazed by Char. She loved life, her family, many friends and colleagues. With no hesitation she would take off for a theater junket or a casino run. Going out to dinner or the movies, up to GEVA or down to the city Charlotte loved it all.

A few years ago she went crazy for working out and in the process lost a bunch of weight. I never thought she had that much to lose, but she did. And as in everything else she succeeded, so much so that something's began to droop a bit which gave her fits. She came to me one day to say that she was going in the hospital for a nip and tuck. I was dumb struck. Yet this was prototypical Charlotte. She was forever young and had no hesitation about adventure.

It goes without saying that her contribution to our school and parish are beyond measure. She has touched more children and adults than one could number. We are impoverished for her loss and heaven is the winner again. Some weeks ago a parishioner died and I told Charlotte about the death during a visit at Strong. As I told her that this person had died she instantly responded: "Good for her." Typically Char, she was delighted that this friend of many years had attained the glory we all seek. Today we too say "Good for you Charlotte. You have given so much to so many and now the reward of your labors flows about you." Go in peace dear friend, keep watch over our labors as they continue on this mortal plain. An until we meet again may God hold you in the palm of his hand. Good Bless you Charlotte and God bless your family and many friends who took such wonderful care of you these last months.

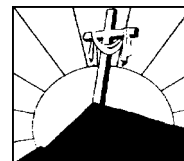

Dear Church Family,

It is with a saddened heart that I write this letter to you, as this week we had to say good-bye to our beloved Charlotte. I will miss Charlotte greatly. I have already missed her as she was away from St. Michael's during her illness. The Parish Center isn't the same without her. Our offices were next to each other, and many times Charlotte and I would yell back and forth to each other in either frustration or joy. She has been a bright spot in my life, and has shown me by example how to be a better person. She was even that way in her dying, as she never complained, and always had a smile for those around her, even while suffering. Her family too was a great example of what love and devotion truly are. As she died (and for months before) she was surrounded by loving family members, friends and caregivers. What a testament to Charlotte that all her caregivers were present when she passed. I too was privileged to be present at that time. And yes, it was a privilege, because I was able to tell her that I loved her, and I was also able to witness first hand the tremendous love that engulfed her.

I personally knew Charlotte for over 25 years. Not long after I came to work here, I interviewed her for a paper I had to write for one of my classes. What stood out to me about Charlotte was her great love for the people of St. Michael's church, which she described as, "my church." She was devoted to the school, having taught there for 18 years, and then serving as principal for 13 years. It was after her retirement from the school, that she came to work as the Liturgy Coordinator for St. Michael's Church. It was in that capacity that I truly got to know her, and she quickly became my friend. I was very scared and unsure of my abilities when I began my job here, and I often sought advice from Charlotte. Not only did she generously give it, but she always did so in a way that didn't make me feel inadequate, and she encouraged me in all I did. For that I will always be grateful.

Charlotte has left a legacy. In many ways she was St. Michael's. I believe her vision, and her inspiring love will carry on. I know that I will continue to ask her for guidance. And I also know that she will continue to give it. We have all been blessed by her in one way or another.

And so I will be praying this week, for Charlotte's family, and for her St. Michael's family as well. And knowing Charlotte, she'll be helping me along the way.
