## Things Considered...

*Another beautiful summer day!  
 Can't have enough of them.*

*This week I want to talk with you about Stephen Ministry. Our parish is blessed to be a Stephen Ministry Parish. We have several parishioners who have been trained to minister in this area and we also have 4 Stephen Leaders.*

*So what is Stephen Ministry? It is a committed group of parishioners, trained and commissioned, who, through prayer and service, reach out to live the Gospel message of Jesus to "bear one another's burdens". It is named after St. Stephen, who was commissioned by the disciples to care for the community's needs.*

*A Stephen Minister is a layperson who has received 50 hours of training in how to provide distinctively Christian care. A trained lay minister who continues to meet twice a month during his/her term of ministry for the purpose of continuing education and peer supervision. At these meetings s/he receives support and help through sharing problems and concerns of the ministry. The Stephen Minister is committed to the rule that "all transactions, all observations or impressions and all records are and must remain confidential."*

*A Stephen Minister is NOT: a counselor or therapist, a problem-solver or a casual visitor.*

*There are some flyers in the gathering space that give you more information about Stephen Ministry. If you have any questions, please contact me, Dan Winkler, or Sue Hartman.*

**Social Ministry:**

Today's Gospel unsettles us. Jesus expects us to wake up. Be alert, ever ready to welcome him just when summer days tempt us to block out the world, to forget about the war, the violence, the suffering in so many places, forget that Jesus often comes to us in distressing disguise. In their recent joint statement calling for comprehensive immigration reform, Bishop Matthew Clark, Imam Muhammad Shafiq, Rabbi Alan Katz and other area religious leaders teach: "The whole earth belongs to God. As Managers and stewards of its resources, we are challenged to give account of how we are mindful of the poor, the widow, the orphan and the foreigner in our midst".

Dear Church Family,

Today's gospel reading from St. Luke continues the theme of last week—as it instructs us to keep vigilant in our faith *"like servants who await their master's return."* In last week's readings we learned that greed gets us nowhere with God (or with ourselves for that matter). I went to Mass at St. Mary's of the Lake in Skaneateles last Saturday, and the priest there said it's not the "things" in life that matter, as he's never seen a U-haul being dragged behind a hearse. Although that was a comical way of getting his point across, this week's gospel reading is even clearer in meaning: *"You must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."* So how do we prepare? By being faithful, and that requires us to live our faith by following Jesus' example. It's not easy, but rather it's a committed process. We must strive to devoutly live out our duties as Christian Catholics, by following the call we received at our baptism. Okay, I'll simplify that by saying we need to *try*.

I read a great commentary on this week's readings by Larry Gillick, S.J., that said, *"As someone once said when asked what do Catholics do, 'Catholics try.' This trying is our being faithful."* I thought that was a great way to put it. We try. We try to be better today than we were yesterday. We try to do what's right, even when it's not the popular choice. We try to live our life as it was meant to be lived—by remembering that God created us in his image, so we need to treat ourselves and each other with respect. We try, and yet we may not see the fruits of this labor. After all, faith is described in the second reading as, *"confident assurance concerning what we hope for, and conviction about things we do not see."* In other words...we eventually will be rewarded for living a faithful life, but that reward may not come in this life—but in the next. Still, that hope is enough to keep me going when I'm having a bad day. Why? Because I have faith that God keeps his promises, and I know that if nothing else—I always try.
