St. Michael's School

In next week's bulletin I hope to announce a new Principal for our school. As you know Shannon Heller, who has served the school for the last two years, has moved to a new position closer to home in Rochester.

Our school has served our parish and surrounding area for fifty-two years. This past June both the Valedictorian, Matt Johnson and the Salutatorian, Conor Healy of Newark High School were graduates of St. Michael's. Katie Litts, also a graduate, was Salutatorian at Midlakes. In addition, several of the top graduates of this year's Newark class graduated from St. Michael's. We can be proud of the accomplishments of these and all of our graduates this year and the past fifty-two years.

An ongoing concern I have for our school is the cost of tuition. I would like to invite you to consider sponsoring a child at the school. Individual tuition is currently at the \$2800 level. Each year we receive far more requests for tuition assistance than we can provide. Perhaps you could defray the cost for a deserving family and child in our school. A parishioner recently approached me with the offer of a substantial gift to the tuition assistance fund. You may consider that option with a gift at any level. Further, you may consider naming the School or the Parish in your will, so that the work of our parish will be sustained beyond your years.

Presently, we are looking for a part-time Spanish teacher for the middle school grades. The candidate must be certified by the State and preferably be an experienced teacher. Again, contact the school for further information.

Dear Church Family,

I'm writing this to you all on Wed. (so our new secretary Katie, can get it in the bulletin—I'm making her a bit crazed) and today we hit the mid-point of our Vacation Bible School program—**FIESTA!** It's been a great week so far with about 100 kids in grades PK—5 participating, and another 35 youth helpers. We also have about 20 adult volunteers. A lot of time, effort and patience goes into planning and presenting a program like this, but when you see the faces of the kids...it is totally worth it! There's been a lot of singing, dancing, crafting, playing, and the like going on...all to reiterate the love that Jesus has for us. It is a wonderful program, and I'd like to thank all those that made it possible with either time, talent or monetary donations. I'm happy to say that over 50% of our participants, and 85% of our youth helpers are from St. Michael's. Many of our adult helpers as well. I am so very proud to be a part of this generous community! As we've been saying all this week in VBS, "**Viva!**"

Okay, now on to this weeks readings, which I had to touch on because they again relate to the most beautiful of sacraments...the Eucharist. I think today's psalm says it best, "*Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.*" Receiving the Eucharist allows us to do just that.
