# St. Michael's Church Newark, New York

This Sunday we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. We "officially" kick off our Religious Education program. We will bless our catechist and teachers who teach in our program, as well as the teachers in our own St. Michael School. I truly appreciate the time, faith, heart and soul that these catechists put into our formation programs. It takes many hours of preparation for them to be ready to educate and form our young people. It is not easy to be a catechist and I commend them for taking the time and initiative to be one of our educators in the faith.

I appreciate all that Jeanette Housecamp does as our Coordinator of Faith Formation and Youth Ministry. She truly loves watching the youth of our parish community grow in faith and love. And she is a significant part of their development as young Catholic men and women.

As a Catholic community, it is part of our obligation and mission to hand on our faith, to continue to build up the Kingdom. However, this handing on is about giving to our young people a living faith, one that gives them vitality and energy to live their faith. We need to encourage them to grow, to explore religious questions asked in light of their contemporary experiences of life. While exploring these religious questions, our young people should be taught in an environment that preserves a creative tension among some basic aspects of Christian belief and practice. God being presented not only as creator, lord and judge, but also as friend, lover and companion. Jesus must be presented not only as comforting and affirming, but also as challenging and demanding. Christian living must be presented as involving both the carrying of the cross and the sharing in the joy of the risen Christ. One-sided emphases in these areas tend to produce religious styles that are either grim or flabby.

This environment needs to be present not only on Sunday mornings at Religious Education, but also in the home. Parents are the primary educator of their children in the faith. Our young people need to be educated in the faith and reinforced in their faith as they discern and discover the presence of God in their lives, their families and their faith community. Growth is a continuous process that needs to be nurtured in their day to day lives.

Thank you to all of our catechists in the Religious Education program, the St. Michael school teachers, and you parents at home. You are planting and feeding the seeds of faith that are maturing into healthy men and women who will live lives of faith and service rooted in the Eucharist and the gospel.
