Eucharistia is the Greek noun which means "thanksgiving."

Although the word is not found in the New Testament, the verb *eucharistein* (to give thanks) is found in several places – in the Last Supper accounts and in the stories about the feeding of the multitudes.

Some of us may be feeding multitudes this week as we celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday. Families and friends gather for a meal where we remember and give thanks for all of our blessings. The pilgrims and Indians gave thanks at the end of their first harvest in 1621. To give thanks is part of our being, part of who we are. The pilgrim and Indian culture was much more attuned to the cycle of life, especially as it pertained to their food source. They could only grow food during certain times of the year, and would offer thanksgiving to God for the harvest that was yielded that year. They acknowledged the generosity and life-sustaining presence of God throughout their daily lives. Being thankful for food, shelter, safety and each other was most important to them. And it should be for us too.

Thanksgiving gives me time to pause and reflect on these past 5 months. My initial thanksgiving is for the growth in my life. It has been very good for me to be planted in new soil and to begin a new growth spurt here at St. Michael's. I have been stretched in many new ways and beyond what I ever imagined myself to be. It is good growth and I am thankful for it.

My second thanksgiving is for the staff here at the parish and in the school. What wonderfully bright and holy people! I am amazed at the talents and gifts of the staff that they possess and give so generously. It is their life in the Spirit that gives me thanks for God's many ways of incarnating himself in our community.

And, I am most profoundly thankful for you, the people of St. Michael's. You have been most hospitable and helpful in my first few months here, giving me encouragement and guidance as we walk this journey together. I am thankful for your presence at Eucharist, giving thanks to God for all that has been given to you in your lives. I so love looking at you during Mass and seeing all of the stories of your lives converging on that moment when we are all giving thanks to God. God becomes real in bread and wine, and in you. As Meister Eckhart said, "If the only prayer you said in your whole life was, 'thank you,' that would suffice."

That is my prayer this Thanksgiving to God for all of you – thank you.

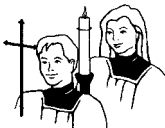
