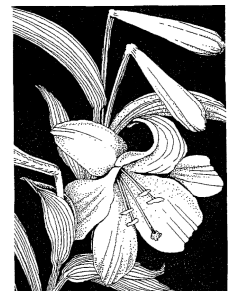

El cirio pascual que encabeza la procesión de entrada a la iglesia durante la Vigilia Pascual es un símbolo dominante en la iglesia durante todo el tiempo de Pascua. Se ve desde la distancia recordándonos que Cristo el Resucitado quitó la oscuridad del pecado y está entre nosotros. Alégrese, todos, porque esta es la noche en que Cristo resucitó del abismo. Esta noche dichosa lava las culpas, devuelve la inocencia a los caídos y la alegría a los tristes. ¡Alégrese!

Este cirio se enciende por toda la celebración de 50 días de la Pascua. Se proclama que Cristo se resucita y nosotros sí podemos resucitar. Usamos este cirio para los bautismos y los funerales: por el bautismo estamos incorporados en el cuerpo de Cristo y tenemos una participación en la resurrección de Jesucristo. The Easter Tree ~ A wonderful story from medieval times traces the wood of the cross on which Jesus died, all the way back to the Garden of Paradise. The story goes that seeds from the tree of life were planted from age to age, until the time of Jesus, when a tree produced from one of its seeds provided wood for his cross. This story may help young children understand that, in spite of appearances, the cross of Jesus brings life—not death.

In Paradise where life began
a wondrous tree grew tall,
that stretched its arms to the tiniest
bird,
and gave God's gifts to all.

And Adam and Eve in the evening
shade
together sang under the tree.
God sang along in their merry
song,
a song so light and free.



But then one day a serpent came
and the beautiful garden grew cold.
The tiny birds flew far away
and songs were no longer told.

So an angel of God took a seed from the tree
and gave it to Adam and Eve.
