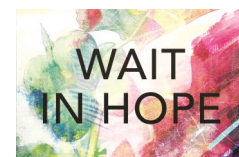

### Catholic Ministries Appeal - "Sharing Our Blessings"

We are very grateful for those who have contributed to this year's CMA. Contributions have been received from 219 households totaling \$41,169 towards our goal of \$44,851. However, this is 28 fewer households than at this same time last year. In dollars, **it is \$4,498 less than last year at this same time.** You may remember that our goal this year is down by \$1,344. **So, we only need \$3,682. After accounting for parishioners who moved or passed away, if every household that contributed last year but hasn't this year, we will make our goal. Please remember that our parish must pay the difference if we do not make our goal.**

For some of our families, financial circumstances may have changed such that they are no longer able to give. We understand. We only ask that you prayerfully consider if and how much you might be able to contribute and do so if and when you can. Our theme this year is "Sharing Our Blessings." How has the Lord blessed you this year? Are you able to share your blessings by supporting the ministries of our diocese?

### Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament



Special Date for April Holy Hour

Normally, we celebrate a monthly holy hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on the third Wednesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. In April this would fall during Holy Week. **So, we are rescheduling our April holy hour for Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.** We hope you can join us as we give this hour to Jesus with prayers, readings from the Bible and a homily by Fr. Jeff. Then we have 20-25 minutes of quiet private prayer before we conclude with Benediction.

### Cuidemos la Tierra y su Agua

Cuidemos lo que Dios ha hecho y regalado a nosotros. Agua es tan precioso y tan necesario para la vida, pero mucha gente por el mundo no tiene bastante. Como parte de nuestra responsabilidad para cuidar la tierra es no malgastar el agua.

Aquí hay algunas sugerencias:

1. No dejes el agua corriendo cuando no la estés usando. Para conservar el agua y ayudar a salvar a la Tierra es no desperdiciarla. Cuando te laves las manos, abre el agua solamente para enjuagarlas. Cuando laves los platos, no dejes el agua corriendo mientras los estás secando. El agua no tiene que estar corriendo durante todo el rato que te lavas los dientes. Siempre toma duchas en lugar de baños. Cierra la regadera cuando te estés enjabonando, y ábrela de nuevo para enjuagarte.
2. Coloca mantillo en el suelo. Puedes ayudar a conservar el agua para salvar a la Tierra al esparcir mantillo en el suelo. El mantillo está compuesto de virutas de madera, ramitas, piedras y otro material de las plantas. Funciona para retener la humedad del suelo. Al colocar mantillo en el suelo, no tendrás que regar el jardín tan frecuentemente.
3. Al cocinar, después de dejar los frijoles en agua, usa esa agua restante para regar las plantas. Las plantas se beneficiarán de los nutrientes del agua.

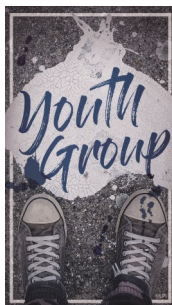
