¿Qué Significa la Resurrección Hoy?

Jesús murió y los discípulos de Galilea volvieron a Galilea donde habían caminado con Jesús, donde habían escuchado su prédica, donde lo habían visto sanar a tanta gente. Supongo que estaban intentando decidir si su compromiso a seguir el ministerio de Jesús terminó con la muerte de Jesús. ¡Tanta esperanza, tantos sueños desaparecieron con esa muerte! O quizás no; quizás la voz de Cristo estaba dentro de ellos preguntándoles: ¿Quién dicen ustedes que soy yo? ¿Sería posible que Jesucristo fuera el Mesías, el ungido, el hijo de Dios? Ellos habían estado con El y les gustó su enseñanza y fueron testigos de sus muchas sanaciones—ambas físicas y espirituales. Empezaron a sentir el deseo de compartir el mensaje y acciones de Jesucristo y la persona de Cristo—un hombre de amor, de fe en su Padre Dios, y de deseo de ayudar a los pobres, los rechazados, y los pecadores. Eventualmente ellos formaron comunidades de creyentes que llegaron a conocer el Resucitado por medio de los apóstoles. Y estas comunidades gozaban las historias recordadas por los discípulos y querían seguir sus enseñanzas y ejemplo.

Cuando Jesús murió, él fue elevado a otro modo de vivir—una nueva vida—a una exaltación. Hubo una transformación desde la muerte a una vida nueva más allá de tiempo y de espacio. Puede ser que los discípulos también experimentaban algo nuevo: una fuerza que recibieron por la vida nueva fluyendo desde el Cristo resucitado. Después por la presencia del Espíritu pudieron compartir con más convicción el mensaje y misión de Jesucristo. Hoy en día es por el Bautismo que recibimos la gracia de Dios para creer en Jesucristo y para compartir ese mismo mensaje y esa misma misión con nuestras familiares, nuestros amigos y nuestros compañeros de trabajo o con otras que pueden aprovechar la enseñanza y las acciones de Cristo. *Hermana Kay*

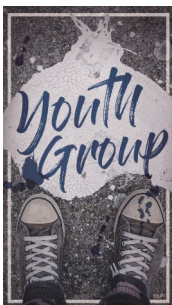
