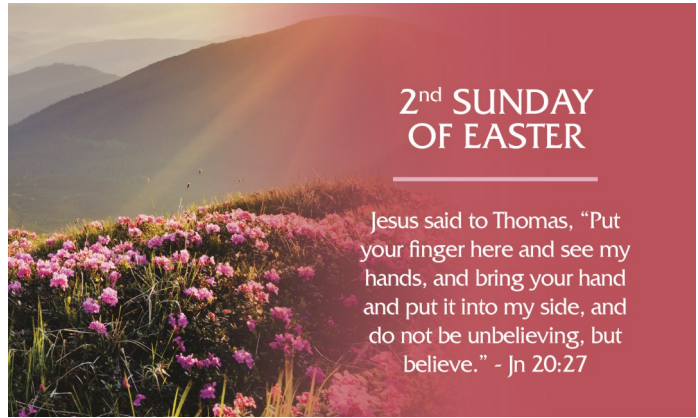

La Paz de Cristo Nos Quita el Miedo

En el evangelio de hoy Jesús les saluda a sus discípulos por un deseo de paz para ellos: "La paz esté con ustedes." Tres veces en la lectura de hoy escuchamos estas palabras: "La paz esté con ustedes." Tanto ellos tenían necesidad de paz. Tenían miedo que los líderes de los judíos iban a buscar a ellos y matarlos como habían hecho a Jesús. Tenían miedo de muerte; estaban dentro de una casa y no querían salir. Jesús entendía; sus discípulos ahora estaban sin un líder; otros mataron su líder, y ellos no sabían qué hacer. Estaban siguiendo el Camino (el camino de la enseñanza de Jesucristo) y Él no estaba vivo. Podríamos decir que ellos tenían miedo porque fueron los discípulos de Él que habían matado.

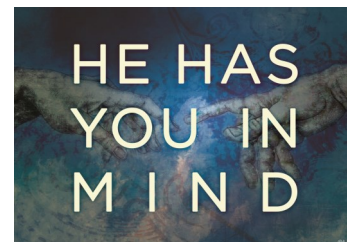
Después de saludar a ellos Cristo sopló el Espíritu Santo sobre ellos. En los Hechos de los Apóstoles podemos ver que una vez que ellos recibieron al Espíritu Santo y la paz de Cristo, el miedo desapareció y con valentía los discípulos pudieron actuar enseñando y sanando como Jesús hacía. A veces nosotros tenemos el miedo de actuar; pensamos más en los posibles resultados negativos a nosotros que en los posibles positivos a otras personas. Ponemos nosotros mismos primero ante de los demás. Hay que pensar en ese saludo de Cristo, "la paz esté con ustedes." La paz contigo, tu compañero y amigo, los otros creyentes... Teniendo esa paz, esa certidumbre que Cristo está con ustedes, ustedes pueden hacer mucho. Cree en la paz que viene de Cristo y con esa garantía, actúa en el nombre de Jesucristo. ¿Para qué o quién estás dispuesto a actuar, dispuesto de salir de tu zona segura? No tengas miedo, ten paz—una paz que te libera de indecisión y miedo. Pon tu mano en la herida de Cristo y cree en la resurrección. Esa herida también es tu herida causada por otra persona deseando quitar de ti tu fuerza que viene de Cristo. Proclama tu fe en la resurrección. Sí, tú puedes hacer mucho por la fuerza que viene de tu fe en Cristo resucitado. Tú puedes sanar muchas heridas en otras personas y en la sociedad si tienes fe en Cristo. No te quedes congelado por el miedo y la duda. Deja la paz de Cristo te penetre, entrando en cada fibra de tu ser. Cristo ya vive dentro de ti y desea actuar por medio de ti. Que goces este tiempo pascual.

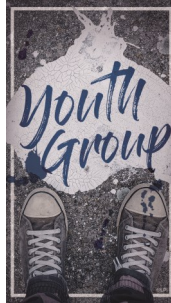
