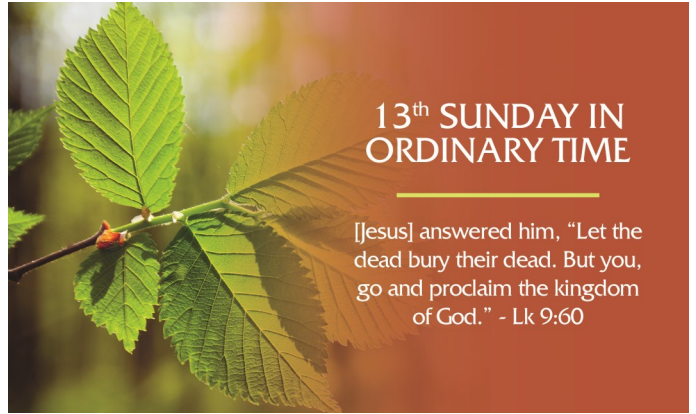

It is a ministry because as we come together to celebrate the Eucharist, people should feel welcome and included in our community.

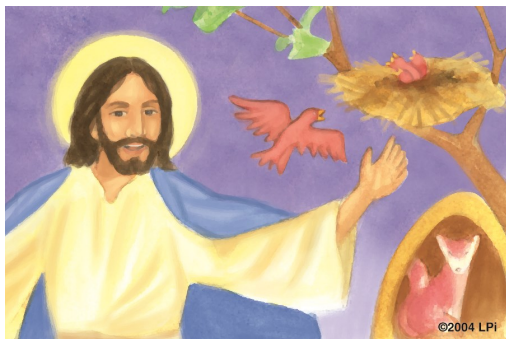
Greeters help to set the tone of a welcoming, thoughtful and loving community. Such a gracious presence strengthens St. Michael Church as a place where people want to belong.

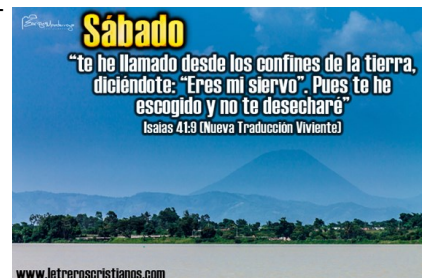
