

Advent is a season of grace when God invites us to journey deeper into his love and his presence. We as faithful disciples should confidently anticipate Jesus' coming with redeeming mercy, and prayerfully attend to Jesus' presence among us already in those who need God's mercy and our care. Let this be our Advent preoccupation: God's mercy for us and our mercy for one another.

Advent, taken from the Latin "advenio," meaning "to come" anticipates not only the coming of Jesus as a child, but is also to prepare Christians for the Second Coming of Christ at the end of time. This anticipatory season is filled with its own symbols as well. One of the most common symbols used in Advent is a wreath with four candles – three purple and one pink (or rose), representing the four Sundays of Advent. The purple, or violet, color represents the penitential nature of Advent. Advent is also a season of penance — we don't think of that, but that's why the color is violet because it is a season of penance and preparation. Advent is also a recognition of our distance from God, still more a season of anticipation and rejoicing but there's a penitential nature to it.

¿Cómo Puedo Encontrar Tiempo para Orar?

"La vida es tan ocupada. ¿Cómo puedo encontrar tiempo para orar?" Con todas las obligaciones de nuestra vida, es tentador dejar la oración para mañana, y luego olvidarlo. ¿Cómo podemos hacer tiempo para la oración?

Madre Teresa de Calcuta dijo: "Si no nos tomamos el tiempo para orar, no podríamos hacer este trabajo." Sabemos que Madre Teresa y las hermanas de su congregación, las Misioneras de la Caridad tenían mucho trabajo entre los pobres de Calcuta. Madre Teresa nunca permitió que ninguna cantidad de trabajo invadiera su tiempo de oración o el de sus hermanas--sin oración, todo lo demás fallaba.

La oración es el corazón de toda vida cristiana, no solo de las órdenes religiosas. Si sacas el corazón, el cuerpo morirá. Si fortalece el corazón, el cuerpo será más fuerte. Si hace mayores exigencias al cuerpo, el corazón puede exigir más.

Frecuentemente dejamos de lado la oración en medio de las constantes demandas del trabajo, la familia, la escuela, el teléfono, la televisión y otras cosas prácticas, pero si no oramos, todos los aspectos de nuestra vida sufren. Una forma de hacer de la oración una práctica constante es programar un tiempo de oración regular para usted en casa. Decida cuántos minutos va a ocupar por la oración cada día y de a poco añada algunos minutos más cada día. También puede programar una hora santa tal vez semanal, tal vez quincenal o mensual. Puede mantenerlo centrado y espiritualmente fuerte para ayudarlo en tiempos de dificultad. Le ayudará a seguir orando incluso si no puede estar con otros por la hora santa.

En este tiempo de Adviento intente empezar un programa de oración, usando el librito de *Palabra entre Nosotros* con las reflexiones. Hable con Dios en sus propias palabras y centrada en su vida. De a poco vaya formando una relación personal con Dios. *Hermana Kay*


