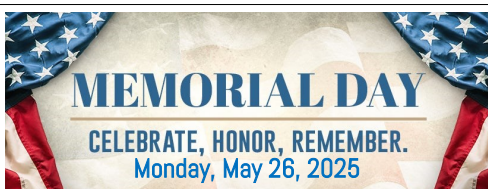
In honor of Our Blessed Mother, the Rosary will be prayed 30 minutes before St. Joseph the Worker weekend Masses during the month of May.

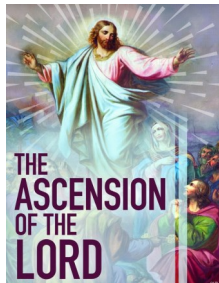

CONFIRMATION

How is the Sacrament of Confirmation

celebrated? Confirmation is usually celebrated during Mass. It's normally the bishop who administers the sacrament, but a priest may do so under circumstances such as at the Easter Vigil. When a parish has adults in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process, they are confirmed at the Easter Vigil Mass. The bishop in this case extends the faculties (permission) for the priest to administer this sacrament. The Sacrament of Confirmation is conferred by the laying of hands followed by an anointing in the form of a cross with chrism, sacred blessed oil, signifying the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, on the forehead. As the candidate for confirmation approaches the bishop (or priest), the sponsor places a hand on the candidate's shoulder as a sign of presenting the candidate on behalf of the Christian community. The power of the Holy Spirit is invoked with the laying of hands and praying for the gift of the Spirit. The laying on of hands is a biblical action that reflects the significance of human touch. In the Gospels, Jesus healed many people with a touch. When Jesus encountered two blind men, he *"touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed him."* (Matthew 20:34) We will continue next week with how the Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated. *Fr. Felician*
